

### Letter from Rob Hatfield



One of my great joys is to share the good news of God's work among our congregation. In the January Finance Committee meeting and Deacons meeting, many highlights were shared based on reflections from 2017 that need to be celebrated. Because there was so much good news, I am

going to share the good news in bullet form.

- An average of 692 people worshiped with us on Sunday mornings in 2017
  - Traditional Worship averaged 515 each week
  - Contemporary Worship averaged 177 each week
  - Our overall worship average increased by 85 in 2017
- Sunday School averaged 580 each week
  - Two new Sunday School classes began in 2017
- 65 People joined Spring Hill Baptist in 2017
  - 33 by Profession of Faith requesting baptism
  - 22 by Letter from other Baptist churches
  - 9 by Statement of Faith and Previous Baptism
  - o 1 by Watch Care
- The 2017 Mission and Ministry Plan (aka 2017 Budget) was \$3,200,906
  - The Undesignated Contributions in 2017 were \$3,453,696
    - 10% of these funds (minus our payments for indebtedness) were given through our local, national and international partnerships

- Our total Lottie Moon offering for International Missions is \$83,821.93
- Our total Annie Armstrong offering for North American Missions is \$20,543.64
- In addition to the contributions of our congregants, The Spring Hill Baptist Foundation dispersed \$52,000 among the following missions causes and missionaries: Adoption Rocks, Alabama Baptist Children's Home, Home of Grace, Light of the Village, McKemie Place, Mobile Rescue Mission, Victory Health Partners, Women's Resource Center, and missionaries Andrew M. and Kandy H.
- The completion (or very nearly completion) of our renovation project & new entrance

The numbers above are more than just numbers; they represent real lives that have been changed by the work of the Holy Spirit as He uses this congregation. I am so excited about how God will use us in 2018!


