It is also good to start the new year with good news. We have some wonderful financial news to celebrate at Spring Hill! Before I

share the news, I need to give the caveat that the financial year of 2017 isn't quite complete because we are still receiving mail that is postmarked on or before December 31, 2017. With that in mind, at this point:

- We have surpassed our Lottie Moon goal of \$26,000 by giving \$33,475. As a reminder, every dollar of this offering goes to support International Mission Board Missionaries who are currently serving around the world.
- We have surpassed our mission and ministry plan (also known as the 2017 budget) of \$3,200,906 by giving \$3,455,156.17.

Praise God! I am so thankful to get to be a part of a church that takes joy in giving generously to the work of the Kingdom locally and around the world!

It is also good to start the new year with new opportunities. If you are a parent, I hope you have already signed up to participate in our 6th Annual Parent Summit to be held January 13 from 4:30-8:15 pm. 
