Letter from Rob Hatfield



There are many of our people who are actively serving here and elsewhere over these next days, so please allow me to update you on both where folks are and how you can be praying for them.

As I write this article our children are on their way to their summer camp experience which will last until Monday, June 25. I already look forward to hearing stories of how our children had fun together, worshiped the Lord and learned more about how to follow Him. I hope you will join me in praying for the children throughout the days they are away from us. In addition to praying for safety, I ask that you would pray for the heart of each child to be open to what the Lord is saying and that they will respond in obedience. Pray also for our adult leaders as they minister to our children, loving them with God's love and pointing them to Him.

Speaking of prayers and of people being away, our students continue to serve the Lord on Choir Tour throughout this week and will be home on Saturday. I've heard and seen good reports of how our students are serving, singing and sharing about Jesus. Pray that our students would finish strong in these last days of tour, and that they would have many opportunities to speak with others about the Lord. As always, I would also ask that you pray for their safety as they travel back to Mobile. As a reminder,

the Homecoming Concert for our Spring Hill Singers will be this Sunday morning, June 24, at 11:00 a.m. REMEMBER - our schedule on Sunday is different in that we will only have our 9:45 Sunday school and 11:00 a.m. worship service.

Also on Sunday morning, we will be the host for the "Distinguished Young Women," which is a gathering of young women from across the 50 states and Washington D.C. who are in Mobile for over two weeks. Many of our families are hosts for these young women and will have opportunities to develop relationships of trust with them during the time. Pray the Lord will use these relationships to encourage those who are already believers and to provide a clear view of what it looks like to be a believer in day-to-day life for those who are not.

Lastly, next week (the week of June 25) is when Josh and Megan Karl will be moving. Please continue to pray that all the logistics for moving will work smoothly even as Josh prepares to begin his ministry here on Sunday, July 1st.

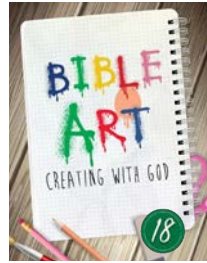
