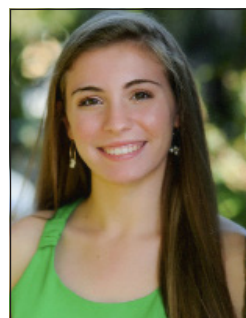

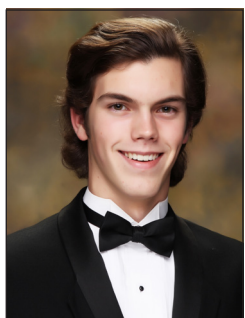

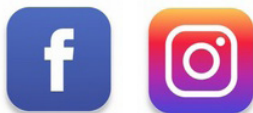
M.A.G.I.C. Friends...You Don't Want to Miss This
