Letter from Rob Hatfield



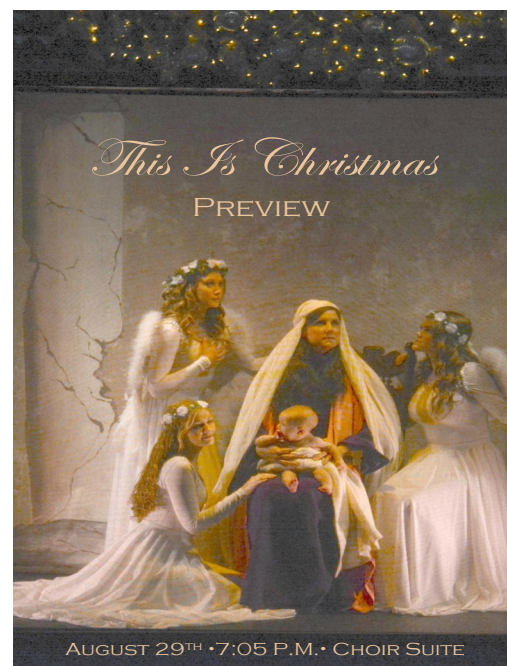

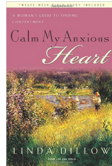
LADIES FALL BIBLE STUDIES
