

## Letter from Rob Hatfield



I am thankful that the winds of tropical storm Gordon did not upgrade into something more severe and that it passed by leaving us relatively unscathed. The fragility of our circumstances and even of our very lives are things we don't often think about until the circumstances we have come to take for granted suddenly

change. Two passages of scripture come to mind when those times come.

James 4:13-15 says, "Now listen, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money.' Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, 'If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that.'"

All of our plans for Tuesday night and Wednesday as a family changed with the sudden arrival of tropical force winds. The amount of "control" we have over the most basic of things is brought into clarity during such times and we do well to remember this truth at all times and not just when a large storm is approaching. We must remind ourselves to continually rely on the Lord's strength and His provision instead of our own - not just in the storms, but in the sunny days as well.

Philippians 4:11-13 says, "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do everything through him who gives me strength." Paul had experienced the tumultuous storms of life and had known that sometimes the outcome of a storm was difficult. At the same time, Paul knew that no matter his circumstances, the one constant he had in life was the Lord. The Lord was enough no matter what storms or challenges awaited Paul. The same Lord is enough for us. He is with us and He is enough for us - at all times, in all situations, and in every setting.

No one wants to go through tropical force winds in life, but as followers of Christ, we can face each storm with the confidence that the Lord has not left us or forsaken us. We can do all things through Christ who gives us strength.
