

Letter from Rob Hatfield



As a reminder, on February 21, 2018 Spring Hill Baptist Church voted to approve the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee "to examine the issue of the lack of women on the Deacon body." As explained on February 21, this committee was designed to be an information gathering team. The committee has taken its role

very seriously and has worked diligently to complete a report for the congregation. The report has 88 pages of content with many additional pages of appendixes that are currently being printed and bound. The report will be available for you to pick up on Sunday morning in the Welcome Center area. I hope you will pick up your copy and will invest the time necessary to prayerfully consider the contents. In next week's article there will be a schedule attached that details the opportunities to ask questions and discuss the information gathered.

Hurricane Michael has done significant damage to areas in close proximity to us, specifically in southeast Alabama and in Florida. Many within our church have family or friends that have been affected personally by the storm. Numerous individuals and small groups have already begun the process of response to those with whom they have personal knowledge. In times like these, it is good to be in partnership with Baptists who are spread across the affected areas. Baptists have disaster relief teams that train throughout the year for times like these. When tornado's struck North Alabama in 2011 I saw the work of these teams from

Alabama and across our country come together to do miraculous work in the community. Chain saw teams, cooking teams, washing clothes teams, chaplains and so many more came and were based out of our church in Huntsville. The work of each of these teams was supported in part through donations that other Baptists from across the country sacrificially gave. I also know from personal experience that the recovery process will take longer than a few days. In addition to partnering with teams who are trained for disasters, we are also reaching out to churches and associations that have been affected seeking ways we can help in the days that come. For now, please pray for those who are affected and pray for clarity regarding the best ways for us to assist the many who have needs in the area.
