A Special Called Business Meeting will be held on Sunday, November 11 at the end of the 8:30 am service in the Dining Hall and the 11:00 a.m. service in the Sanctuary for the sole purpose of voting on the following motion:

"The Deacons will instruct all future Deacon Election Committees that our Bylaws are gender neutral and therefore allow any eligible member of Spring Hill Baptist Church to be considered for the office of Deacon, regardless of marital relationship (husband and wife) unless the Bylaws are changed."

All Spring Hill Baptist Church members 16 years old and older will vote by ballot. It is our intent that all discussion will take place in the Congregational Meetings on Sunday, November 4 and Thursday, November 8 and the vote taken on Sunday, November 11 will be without discussion.

Saturday, November 10, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. has been set aside as a Day of Prayer. This is a very important decision for our church family. The Sanctuary will be open for our church family to pray throughout the day.
