YEAR-END GIVING OPTIONS

Spring Hill Baptist Church members may contribute their tithes and offerings through giving appreciated stock. Appreciated stock is a good way to contribute to the church, because capital gains taxes are not assessed, and your contribution goes further. You can give more by giving stock and being found faithful in your tithes and offerings to do God's work at Spring Hill. If you plan to transfer stock, please call Denise Marsh at 251-342-5320 and she can help you with this transfer to the church.

Seniors Can Save Taxes with an IRA Charitable RMD

A popular way to transfer IRA assets to Spring Hill is via a tax provision which allows IRA owners who are 70 ½ or older to direct up to \$100,000 per year of their IRA distributions to the church. The transfer counts toward the donor's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), but does not increase the donor's taxable income, thereby helping to reduce income taxes. Congress made this technique permanent in 2015. Please talk to your tax advisor and IRA Administrator about how to make a charitable rollover to the Spring Hill ministries.
