The top vote getters were submitted to the Financial Secretary to be evaluated in terms of tithing and regular attendance. That list included several women.

That report was delivered to the 5-member committee which then voted on whether or not each individual should be forwarded to be considered for the final ballot. This vote was taken after discussion of the Scriptural qualifications as understood by the committee members.
