

Letter from Rob Hatfield



Happy New Year! I hope that you and your family had a wonderful holiday season and a fantastic beginning to 2019.

Psalm 115:1 says, "Not to us, O Lord, not to us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness." As I read this verse this morning it resonated deep within me. Maybe you are like me in that at the beginning of every year

you reflect on the past year and make resolutions for how you can improve in the year to come. As I reflect on 2018, I am amazed by the love and faithfulness of the Lord. I know 2018 had some difficult personal challenges for specific individuals in our congregation, but I also know that the Lord's love and faithfulness were enough for each person no matter the challenge, obstacle, or loss. Lamentations 3:22 says it this way, "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."

In addition to the personal challenges many of us faced, I also know there were some challenges for our congregation as a whole. In every situation we faced, the Lord was faithful in His provision for us. Certainly we have always strived to do this, but I invite you to consider anew, at the beginning of this year, how we can better make His name glorious to the nations? How can we better join our hearts together because of His love and faithfulness to proclaim the greatness of who He is and how He has loved us? I look forward to beginning a new series of sermons from the book of Acts that will hopefully allow the Lord to show us how He has used His people in the past to "make His name glorious" and advance His Kingdom even as we seek to do so today.


