During the first seventeen weeks of 2019, you have given \$984,498, and we have had expenses of \$963,032 giving us a year-to-date balance of \$21,466 as of April 30, 2019. We have baptized 11 people and have averaged 545 in Sunday School and 644 in Worship. Dr. Chuck Kelley is the 8th president of New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary and also Professor of Evangelism. He received his B.A. from Baylor University and his M.Div. and Th.D. from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. Before his

election to the presidency in 1996, Dr. Kelley served as Director of the Leavell Center for Evangelism and Church Growth and Chairman of the Pastoral Ministries Division at the seminary.

He has written numerous books, articles, and evangelism training materials which include:
