Christian Generosity is Always a Response to Faith!

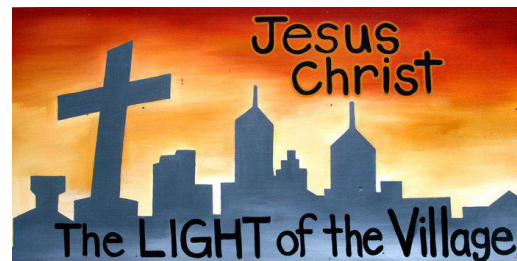
