adult sons. He holds a Bachelor of Arts, Mercer University; Master of Divinity, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary; and Doctor of Philosophy, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He served as Senior Pastor, Second-Ponce de Leon Baptist Church, Atlanta, Georgia, 1999-2012. Prior to that he served Derbyshire Baptist in Richmond, Virginia and John's Creek Baptist, Chamblee, Georgia. He was Director of Organization, Christian Life Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention, 1976-1981. Additionally, he served as adjunct professor at Candler School of Theology, Emory University, McAfee School of Theology, Mercer University, and Theological Seminary at Richmond.


