

How Do I Participate

1. **On Sunday, August 11**, commit to fill a backpack and pick up a backpack **AFTER** the 8:30 or 11:00 service in the foyer of the Dining Hall or Sanctuary.
2. **Fill a backpack.** Inside each backpack will be a list of supplies you can follow to fill your backpack.
3. **Fill out the tag** inside the backpack declaring what age child you have filled your backpack for and attach it to the handle of the backpack.
4. **Bring your filled backpack** back to the foyer of the Dining Hall or Sanctuary by Sunday, August 25.

Gift Suggestions:

TOYS: Small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, small musical instruments, yo-yos, jump ropes, sidewalk chalk, toys that light up or make noise (include extra batteries), Slinky, frisbee, card games such as Old Maid, Go Fish, etc.

ART SUPPLIES: Crayons, colored pencils, markers, stamps and ink pads, craft paper, construction paper, coloring and picture books, stickers, etc.

HYGIENE ITEMS: Toothbrush, toothpaste, boxed bar soap (in a plastic bag), hair brush, comb, wash cloth, ponytail holders, hair clips, etc.

OTHER: Age appropriate Children's Bible or Teen Bible, hard candy (no chocolate), lollipops (double bag all candy), mints, age-appropriate Christian books, pop-top cans of food, t-shirt, socks, gloves, hat, etc.

PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE items that can be easily crushed or broken, perishable food, food containing nuts, or knives.

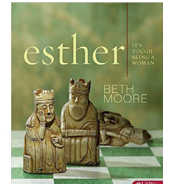
