Five Reasons for Giving

The giving verses in the Bible–Luke 6:38, Malachi 3:8-10, Proverbs 3:9,10, and others— are often spoken as commands, followed by a promise of rewards. Why does God both command us and also says, "If you obey, think about how I am going to bless you?" The apostle Paul lived on the brink of eternity. What he saw behind him was all temporal, and what he saw ahead of him was all eternity. All eternity was the true reality; what was behind him was not reality at all. Thus, I am going to give you five reasons you should give:

1. Give in order to obey God.

2. Give in order to experience the rewards that God promises. These rewards are very clear in Scripture. Philippians 4:17, Luke 6:38, and Matthew 25 all talk about what happens when

we obediently give.

3. Give in order to recognize God's ownership and provision. When I give, I open my hands from grasping what God has entrusted to me. I do not know the answer to the question, "How much is enough?" Yet I do know this: You cannot accumulate enough to be secure, to be significant, or to be successful. The cure for fear and for the lack of security and

significance is to understand that God owns it all.

4. Give in order to gain an eternal perspective. Matthew 6:19-21 says that when I send my treasures on ahead, laying them up in heaven, I am gaining an eternal perspective. I love the name of Randy Alcorn's organization, Eternal Perspective Ministries. That truth is exactly the answer to fear. Do'l have an eternal perspective? Your net worth is what you have given, not what you have accumulated. Think about that. If you took your balance sheet and added up all that you have given, saying, "That is my net worth, which very well may be in eternity," what would it do to your giving? I am not sure that I really believe that truth. I know that I believe it intellectually, but when it comes down to putting it into practice, I do not act as if I believe it. However, I do believe that the principle of gaining an eternal perspective is, in fact, a summation of the entire issue of giving. Giving is not a matter of techniques; rather, it is a matter of the decisions that you make.

5. Give in order to love God. The last motive for giving is the one that our Lord expressed in 2 Corinthians 8:9: "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for our sakes he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich." As the love of God permeates your heart, you will see maximum giving.
