On Wednesday, October 16 in the regular monthly Business Meeting, additional information will be shared and some time for discussion will be available. This meeting will be from 6:15 – 7:30 p.m. in the Dining Hall.

On Sunday, October 20, a Special Called Business Meeting will be held at the end of the 8:30 a.m. Contemporary Service in the Dining Hall and at the end of the 11:00 a.m. Traditional Service in the Sanctuary for the purpose of voting to call Dr. Rob Jackson as Interim Pastor.
