A LITTLE BETTER THAN THE DEVILS

Joseph Alleine the puritan minister wrote "O miserable man, what a deformed monster has sin made you! God made you a little lower than the angels; Sin has made you a little better than the devils." "A little better than the devils". So... What does that make me? I'm sure I don't like the answer.

As a believer in Christ I genuinely have Him in my life. But I am a saved sinner carrying around a little of Jesus. What I desire is more of the Spirit, however trying to get more of Jesus is hard. Maybe it is that I don't need more of Jesus, but that he wants more of me. He wants to make me like him, yet if I am trying to stuff Christ into my self I truly leave little room for Him.

The following by C. S. Lewis explains it:

Christ Says "Give me All. I don't want so much of your time and so much of your money and so much of your work: I want You... Hand over the whole natural self, all the desires which you think innocent as well as the desires you think wicked---the whole outfit. I will give you a new self instead. In fact, I will give you Myself; my own will shall become yours."

Christ has not come to make us moral people; He did not die so we could be good little churchmen carrying him as our talisman. His purpose was to bring us to His father to bring us into His family, to know us and be with us in close relationship. He desires all of us in relationship with Him so in that communion with Him we are transformed through fellowship with Him.

Instead of thinking of church as a place to go, think of it as a dimension of your relationship in Christ. Worship, Sunday school, Bible study, fellowship, choir, student group, missions... all a part of this communion with Christ and with His body. See yourself as BEING Christ's man or woman. Join Him in relationship as you join others in activity. Give him more than your sin to forgive, your piece of Sunday or Wednesday... give him yourself. As followers of Christ at Spring Hill, Let us all join together allowing this place to be transformed by giving ourselves fully to Christ.

Let him move us away from "a little better than the devils" to being like the Son.
