## RELATIONSHIPS 101

*"I've learned that people will forget what you said, people will forget what you did, but people will never forget how you made them feel."* Maya Angelou

The word "Christian" can be translated "little Christ." We at Spring Hill Baptist Church call ourselves Christian because we have at some point encountered Christ. In that encounter he has forgiven us our sins, changed our status from enemy of God to Friend of God and given us the Holy Spirit as comforter and guide. Our position has changed, but what about our disposition? Are we allowing the Spirit to transform us into "little Christ"? Not just an imitation but an embodiment of Christ Himself. Not just *what would Jesus do?* But *"How can I be Christ?"*

Think of how Christ made people feel. Remember the dignity he gave the woman at the well? The acknowledgment of Zacchaeus as a person? The calling of Matthew and the others...the widow...Mary Magdalene...Peter... and the list continues... He could have announced his authority and substantiated it with incredible power, yet, even confronting the worst of evil His power came from God not a sense of superiority and bravado.

Yes... at home, in our church, at work, in the world... and, it is a difficult task. Therefore, let us continue to pray for ourselves, encourage one another and pray for Christians worldwide that we could truly have the mind of Christ so the world may know of the Hope we have and join the Kingdom.

In your relationships with one another, have the same attitude of mind Christ Jesus had:

*Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a human being, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross! Philippians 2:5-8 TNIV*

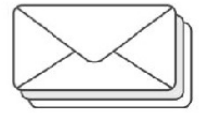
