

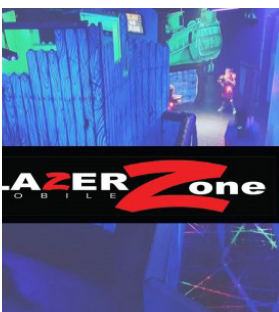

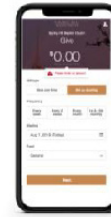
And In Closing

Mark 14 describes for us an inspiring story of worship. **Mark 14:3-6** says, "And while he was at Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he was reclining at table, a woman came with an alabaster flask of ointment of pure nard, very costly, and she broke the flask and poured it over his head. There were some who said to themselves indignantly, 'Why was the ointment wasted like that? For this ointment could have been sold for more than three hundred denarii and given to the poor.' And they scolded her. But Jesus said, 'Leave her alone. Why do you trouble her? She has done a beautiful thing to me.'" And then later in verse 9 Jesus says, "And truly, I say to you, wherever the gospel is proclaimed in the whole world, what she has done will be told in memory of her." 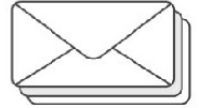
