

SMALL ADJUSTMENTS

Small adjustments can make a huge difference in the long run. Consider these examples:

One simple but powerful temperature degree shift. At 211 degrees you have hot water. At 212 degrees you have steam. For every single degree a pilot flies off course, he or she will miss their targeted landing spot by 92.15 feet for every mile they fly. Let's say you decided to start at the equator and fly around the earth, one degree off would land you almost 500 miles off target. Imagine you were to let go of the steering wheel while driving I-10. You would begin to drift. But with your hands on the wheel you are making small adjustments all the time.

Little one degree course corrections can make a big difference over time.

Leaving off that second helping at dinner. Spending just ten more minutes a day with your child, or going back to kiss your spouse before you leave. Taking just a few minutes in your day to spend with the Heavenly Father and listen for His voice and direction. Reading truths of God's Word regularly. Over time these things can make a huge difference.

Think about the small things you can do to adjust your life for the better. Ask God to show you how you can improve your life and the lives of those around you.

Join me Sunday and together let's allow God to make those little adjustments that make huge differences.

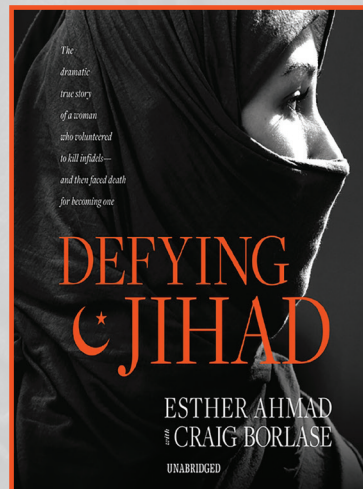

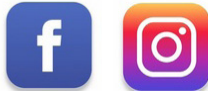
