We moved into a neighborhood that had lots of odd streets that wound around and connected to one another in a seemingly random fashion. About the second week there I decided to go jogging early one dark and overcast morning. In the maze of streets I lost my bearings and couldn't for the life of me find my way back to the house. I was getting tired, it was moving closer to time for work, and for a moment I got anxious. I stopped, took a breath and began to hear traffic. It was from the busy street that ran in front of the neighborhood. I knew if I got there I could find my bearings, so I followed the noise of the traffic and eventually found my way home. I was actually very near my house but in the dark with no stars and with my disorientation, I had no idea where I was.

Similarly, in the bombardment of life and family responsibilities, jobs and viruses, political rhetoric and media, it is easy to become disoriented and wander away from the one who loves us most. However, we have the opportunity these forty days prior to Resurrection Sunday to reorient, allow Christ to be our beacon, and set our hearts toward home. I ask you to join me and many other fellow Christ-followers to use this Lenten Season to focus on our Christ.

Dr. Jackson has prepared a brochure for a Plan of Fasting and Prayer. Additionally, many of our congregation have contributed to a devotion booklet for this season. Please use these resources, and let's join together in a time of returning to what is most important. Spend time in prayer and in the Holy Scripture. Give time to the Holy Spirit and let Him work in us individually and as His church.
