Recently it seems I have encountered friends going through more difficult situations than usual. There have been serious health issues, caring for aging parents, financial challenges, depression, marital discord, job issues and the list continues. Often I hear people say "Well God won't give us more than we can bear." However that is NOWHERE in scripture. In fact, the contrary is evident. What it does say is that God will never allow us to be tempted without an exit strategy or a way out. It is talking about temptation but not difficulties.

Even Paul in Second Corinthians speaks of being beyond his human capability to hold up:

We don't want you in the dark, friends, about how hard it was when all this came down on us in Asia province. It was so bad we didn't think we were going to make it. We felt like we'd been sent to death row, that it was all over for us. As it turned out, it was the best thing that could have happened. Instead of trusting in our own strength or wits to get out of it, we were forced to trust God totally—not a bad idea since He's the God who raises the dead! And He did it, rescued us from certain doom. And He'll do it again, rescuing us as many times as we need rescuing. You and your prayers are part of the rescue operation—I don't want you in the dark about that either. I can see your faces even now, lifted in praise for God's deliverance of us, a rescue in which your prayers played such a crucial part.

2 Corinthians 1:8-11 The Message

Life often is difficult, even to the point of despair. However, those of us who have placed our trust in Christ have been given The Holy Spirit. He is there to walk with us, to give us comfort and wisdom and to help hold us up and carry us when we can't seem to carry ourselves. He has also given us the church, the Body of Christ. In this body we intercede for one another with prayer; we come alongside one another with personal presence, casseroles, chocolate and the like. We as the body of Christ, step in and do whatever is necessary when one of our spiritual family needs help.

So, no, God does not protect us from all challenges and difficulties. Yes, often it is beyond our ability to bear, but oh we do have an advocate in our God and in His people. May we learn to let go and lean upon Him and our brothers and sisters when we are challenged.


