When the Lent season began, I asked God to show me what He wanted me to give up for Him. I knew it couldn't be food because I had been sick and was taking medicine; so, I sincerely prayed about it. I couldn't think of anything that seemed an appropriate sacrifice; so, sadly to say, I have not fasted.

Then, yesterday, while I stood in my front yard praying for our neighborhood and our world, God impressed upon me that this time of being separated from people we love and the places we love to go can be used as a time of fasting; a time to humble ourselves in God's eyes and to draw closer to our Savior, Jesus Christ. During this crisis, we need to care for people; but, we also need to remember to use the time we would normally be connecting and socializing with people to focus on Christ and our personal relationship with Him.

These last two- plus years, God has reminded me that spending time with Him, and glorifying Him, is to be the motivation for everything. While I stood in my yard and prayed for healing for everyone who is sick and protection for those I loved, questions flooded my mind. "Why. Why do I want healing and for this deadly virus to go away? Do I want it just so everything can go back to the way it's been? Do I want people not to suffer? Do I just want normalcy, so I won't be uncomfortable or worried? Although none of these reasons are bad because God tells us to pray about everything, the thought occurred to me that my prayer should be God would provide healing according to His plan in order for Jesus Christ to be glorified.

I know God is working in ways we cannot know. Jesus's name is being heard on the news channels on television more than I've ever heard before. They are even allowing a "Faith Moment" for ministers to share an encouraging word! Jesus is getting lots of publicity all of a sudden.

Families are spending quality time together again as evidenced by my neighborhood. No more running from one event after another. Families, Mom's and Dad's and their children are walking and riding bicycles together; and, it's like a pet parade most evenings with everyone walking their dogs down the street.

Yes, I pray God will heal people who are sick and dying, and yes I pray He will destroy the Coronavirus; but, more importantly, I pray that through it all He will be glorified and that lost people, some whom are very close to me, will turn to Him and be saved; that believers in Jesus Christ, especially this believer, will draw closer to Him and love Him more!


