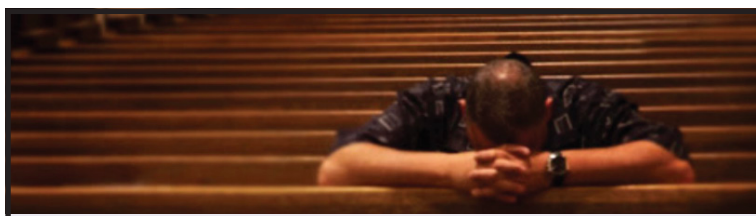
There is no K5 this season. There is not a 5th and 6th-grade league this season.



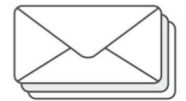

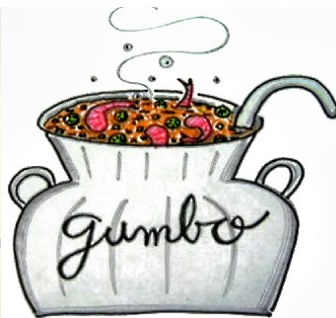
