

#### WHO DO YOU TRUST?

We are being peppered with political ads as we approach election time. Statements are being made accusing the opponent of all sorts of egregious acts, and quite honestly none of us are quite sure of the truth on either side. Most of us are just ready for it to all be over with, yet

the anxiety about the future is worrisome to every person no matter the persuasion. This is not only true of politics but of the COVID crisis and hurricane predictions as well. Again, who can we trust?

With each lie revealed we become more disillusioned and cynical. We are less apt to place much trust in anyone or anything.
