We are temporarily moving back to Spring Hill @ Home. As there has been a spike in COVID-19 numbers in our area, coupled with a number of our families and individuals of all ages presenting symptoms and testing positive for COVID 19, we will be returning to Virtual Worship on Sundays. This Sunday the sermon will be available beginning at 8:45 a.m. and you will receive a link to watch it. You will also have the opportunity to find it on our webpage and Facebook.

We anticipate a minimum of two weeks and likely longer in order for the risk to subside and vaccines to be more prevalent. 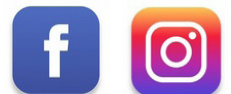


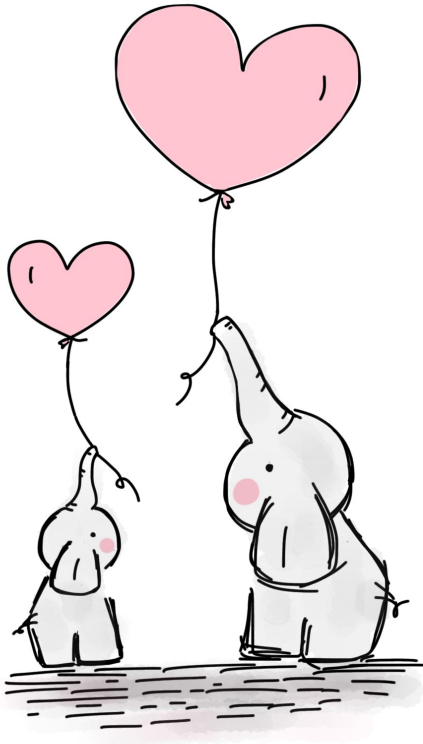
