DON'T MISS THE CALL



"Hello...we've been trying to reach you regarding your vehicle's extended warranty."

How many times a day do we get these calls? I have ceased responding to unknown numbers and don't rush to answer calls at all. It is terribly

annoying. It is easy to hit the silence button and go on with my business.

This caused me to wonder how many times I do the same to the nudging of the Holy Spirit. I am busy in the midst of my day or task and there is a prompting, but I place Him on hold. I am treating the moving of God like a SPAM call. When God interacts with us, He wants to either work in us or work through us, but too often I ignore Him.

The best way to remove the SPAM filter from the Lord is to intentionally spend time talking and LISTENING to Him. We then reacquaint ourselves with the sound of His voice and the movement of His Spirit in us.

So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating,

going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for Him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what He wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.
