Rescue Mission Ministry



PLEASE HELP: FOOD DONATIONS


Items are being collected in marked boxes in the Education Office, the Activities Center and on the second floor of the Adult Sunday School Building.

PRACTICE MAKES PROGRESS

Time and time again we have all heard the phrase "practice makes perfect". It sounds good, but it is not necessarily true. Actually, practice makes progress; particularly in relationships. More specifically, practice makes progress in our Spiritual relationship. We evangelicals have placed a great deal of emphasis on sharing the Gospel, and rightly so; but too often we work to make converts. Christ never called us to make converts, but to make disciples. A disciple is a learner, a follower. Converts tend to accept the dogma, believe that Christ is God's son, begin to attend church (sometimes) but fail to become disciples. The disciple continues to learn, follow and practice the way set forth by Christ.

We as disciples need to be reminded to practice. We need the practice of meeting together, the practice of confession, the practice of encouraging one another, praying for one another, sharing in ministry with one another and looking for ways to practice the love demonstrated by Christ with those in our community. Good musicians` continue to practice the instrument they play (see Missy and Bill) even though they are quite proficient. Just as athletes practice day after day their sport, physicians, teachers, preachers and computer technicians hone their skills and abilities; we as disciples of Christ must continue to practice following Him.

The best place to do this is in community or what we call the church. This is why we are admonished not to neglect joining together, encouraging one another, spurring each other on to knowing our Christ more.

A Call to Persevere

Therefore, my friends, since we have confidence to enter the sanctuary by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain (that is, through his flesh), 21 and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us approach with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful. And let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good deeds, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day approaching. Hebrews 10:19-25
