

Dear God,

We thank you that you are a God who was seen and heard and touched by the hands of the disciples. Sometimes, it all seems like just a really amazing story ... but then we realize that not only was it the MOST amazing story, it was the truest story that ever existed. The most impactful story that ever occurred. Yet, the story is far from over, and You've invited us into it...

We proclaim to you the One who existed from the beginning, whom we have heard and seen. We saw Him with our own eyes and touched Him with our own hands.

He is the Word of life. 1 John 1:1

We are then faced with the most important decision of our lives – will we accept Your grace-soaked invitation to step into Your story? Once we accept this invitation, as individuals, believers, and parents, we are faced with an entirely different set of questions ... What character will I play in this Holy Narrative?
