OUR BUTTERFLY HOUSE


Our Butterfly House will be going up Monday, March 29. If you'd like to help provide plants for the Butterfly House, we could use the following:

Mostly I believe however it was because we reduced Christianity to a formula and lifestyle rather than fully embracing the relationship we have been given with Christ and His church.

When the disciples saw and heard Christ talking to His Father, they responded with "Lord, teach us to pray like that." Maybe you and I could make that our prayer as well, so that through the relationship, we could more fully know the grace and love we are given. Then, we would be more willing to be honest with God, with ourselves and with one another; and in turn become less judgmental and more graceful in our human relationships.

Can I really stand here unashamed Knowin' that your love for me won't change?
