As I have discovered, ever more readily, over the last few days, one's challenges and focus can change in an instant. Through this relatively brief process, Pat and I have experienced varied emotions. When we first received the news of Pat's pancreatic cancer, we were so numb that we could not even process appropriate questions. As things progressed, friends began to surround us with prayers and texts of support. We asked for prayers that the pathology report would come back benign. That was not the case. Then we asked for wisdom to know the right oncologist to pursue. Wow, little did we know that God would orchestrate such an incredible pathway to our physician and his team. Our physician has connections with our new neighbor and friends of ours everywhere. We have been assured we are in the best hands by so many in the medical field as well as friends.

We understand the road ahead will not be one of ease. None of us are promised that. I know, because over almost forty years I have stood at the bedside of so many of you going through the same types of struggles. You granted me the privilege of being an intercessor and minister. You have allowed me to be of support as well as to cry alongside you when I knew nothing else to do and my heart was hurting for you. Through all the years, you have been our family and continue to be.

For now, I will continue to be in the office as much as possible, and Pat is continuing to work from home when she is able. You and the leadership have allowed me the gift of freedom to be with her when needed, but I will continue to come to the office and work in tandem with the staff as associate pastor and administrator. This is what is best for my mental health as well as Pat's and what is most helpful for the church right now. We have a long-tenured staff that has been through four pastoral transitions and multiple obstacles in the last thirty-plus years. Your confidence in us to lead keeps us wanting to offer our best.

Pat and I have already experienced answered prayers which gives us the assurance of His presence even in the midst of this challenge. Who knows what will come of this time? Of course, we are praying for healing. That is not to be selfish, but it is our desire. How God will use this in our lives and our church remains to be seen. But ultimately, our desire is that through this, our family, our friends, our church and our acquaintances will learn to trust and follow our Christ more and more. Sometimes it is difficult to remember that He loves us and ultimately is working for our good.

Now understand, in all that I have just expressed there are and will be days I will not have this sentiment, for I am human. There will be days of fear, anger and question. Yet, ultimately, I know I am not in control, and there will be no recourse in the end but to trust.

Pray for healing. Pray for strength and courage. Pray for God's presence, and pray that you too will learn to lean on Christ as we move forward.
