### THE HOLLOW OF HIS HAND

Spring in Alabama brings warmer temperatures, bright green leaves on all the shrubs and trees, longer days, and welcome bright sunshine! In addition, it brings spring storms. One would be hard pressed to find many places in our state that have never been affected by severe thunderstorms, and even spring tornadoes. And, on the heels of the spring storm season, those of us on the Gulf Coast will face the beginning of hurricane season! But, we are a resilient people and we know how to prepare and how to clean up.

The disciples knew something about storms. Once, they were in a boat with Jesus sailing across a lake and Jesus went to sleep. A terrible storm arose and the boat began taking on water from the crashing waves and the disciples were terrified. They awakened Jesus crying "Teacher, don't you care that we are going to drown?" I'm sure you recall Jesus' response: He said, "Peace, be still." And the winds and sea obeyed Him and instantly became calm. It's interesting to note that this story is recorded in scripture three times: Luke 8:22-25, Matthew 8:23-27; and Mark 4:36-41.

A pastor once said that we all find ourselves either about to enter a storm, in the midst of a storm, or just coming out of a storm. Indeed, sometimes it feels as though we face multiple storms simultaneously! In those moments it's easy to cry out to the Lord like the disciples did, but powerful storms can build powerful faith. We need only to put ourselves in the hollow of the hand of the one who holds us and trust Him. Much easier said than done, right? Consider the lyrics to the following anthem.

'Til the Storm Passes By – written by Mosie Lister

In the dark of the midnight have I oft hid my face While the storm howls above me, and there's no hiding place 'Mid the crash of the thunder, Precious Lord, hear my cry Keep me safe till the storm passes by.

'Till the storm passes over, till the thunder sounds no more Till the clouds roll forever from the sky Hold me fast, let me stand in the hollow of Thy hand Keep me safe till the storm passes by.

Many times Satan whispered There is no use to try For there's no end of sorrow, there's no hope by and by But I know Thou art with me, and tomorrow I'll rise Where the storms never darken the skies.

Till the storm passes over, till the thunder sounds no more Till the clouds roll forever from the sky Hold me fast, let me stand in the hollow of Thy hand Keep me safe till the storm passes by.

While it is undeniably miraculous that Jesus calmed the storm, perhaps the more salient point is that He was WITH them through the storm. He never promised us that by following Him we would never face storms, nor that He would calm them. He DID promise us that He would never forsake us and that He would always be with us. When He spoke those words, "Peace, be still" might He have also been speaking to the disciples as well as the wind and the waves? Whatever storms you may be going through, know that Jesus is right there with you every moment of the day, every step of the way. Rest confidently in the hollow of His hand until the storm passes by.
