THE VINE AND THE BRANCHES

Dear Children.

I use that term in a pastoral sense. We are all Children of the Father. He has given us this Body of Christ and called us together. You have nurtured, guided and prayed for me as a minister since 1983. Amazing isn't it? Therefore, now I speak to you not as The Shepherd but as one of many shepherds who are at Spring Hill.

What we have experienced in the last few years has been less than being led by The Shepherd. It has been fractious, dissentious and quite honestly self-serving on many counts. Authority is a word that has been thrown about as if we were in a hierarchical establishment. Each of us has convictions about biblical authority, but very few of us have acted in a "biblical" way. For if we had, this would have dissipated years ago. We as a church have so mirrored what we have seen in our political world that it has become downright egregious. Yes, we have looked like the world we are called to come out from.

I dare say that there is not a one of you who does not want to follow biblical principles. However, I believe that we must follow what Christ put forth as <u>Biblical</u>. Look at His life. Read the Gospels and once again see how He responded to people. See how He treated those who had been passed over and rejected by the "scripturally religious". We as a Southern Baptist Church have always emphasized the primacy of Scripture. And that is admirable. Yet, we must interpret Scripture in light of God with Us, Jesus Christ, not the other way around, lest we become the Pharisees who held to the law but ignored the Giver of the Law; the very ones we are so ready to criticize. The question is, "are we following Christ?" Christ revealed the ultimate truth of Scripture by His life. God sent Him not only to redeem the world but to show the world what the Father was like! Look at His life, learn from Him.

When we ask "what would Jesus do?" - read what He did. He healed, He loved the sinner, He touched the leper and the broken, He associated with the "wrong kind of women and the worst of men", He called women and men to follow Him, He turned over tables and braided whips in the temple attacking those who were trying to profit and build themselves up through religion. Jesus stepped outside of the "religious norm" to "seek and save those who were wandering lost." How do we follow this Christ?

It is revealed in the words He spoke. These words from John are what we are to do.

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. ² He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. 3 You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. 4 Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

⁵ "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. 6 If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷ If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸ This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

⁹ "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. 10 If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. 11 I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. 12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command. 15 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. 16 You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. ¹⁷ This is my command: Love each other. John 15:1-17

Dear children, Let us follow Christ that the world may know the love of the One whom we profess.
