Special Called Business Meeting for Sunday, May 23, 2021

Wednesday, May 12, 2021 in the regularly scheduled business meeting, a motion to amend the bylaws was presented and seconded. Discussion followed, but no vote was taken as an amendment to the bylaws requires special notice and two-thirds vote to pass.

The motion is as follows:

I move to amend Article III, Section 4, Paragraph A of the Bylaws of SHBC to insert gender specific language describing the Deacons. In the interest of church unity and to exceed a 2/3 vote, each voter may instruct the tellers to change his or her vote to be in accordance with the majority vote.

The vote will be taken by written ballot in both morning worship services on Sunday, May 23, 2021, with provisions for a drive through voting process under the portico on the chapel side from 9:30 - 10:30 a.m. for those who are health compromised.

Please be in prayer for unity as we strive to move forward to be the Church Christ is calling us to be.

The portion of the SHBC Bylaws which are affected by this motion to amend reads as follows:

ARTICLE III: CHURCH OFFICERS

Section 4: Deacons

A. <u>Composition</u> The body of Deacons shall be composed of thirty-three (33) active members of the Church...

AM I FOLLOWING JESUS?

In the first century, before there were churches and cathedrals, before there were synods and conventions, before there were "house churches" and, yes, before Christ was worshipped in congregations, there were followers of Jesus. These women and men formed groups which became communities of love, sharing posessions equally and practicing the teachings they had received from Christ because they had been transformed by His love. It was for them a whole new way of doing life. It was as if their eyes had been opened to seeing themselves and others in a new way.

Following Jesus was not easy. Following Jesus in His way of living went against the popular culture which had definite expectations and rules about place in society leaders and servants, adults and children, racial separation, religious separation and gender separation. Even within the religious arena this was practiced, but Christ came and opened up the door for a new way of living based on His authority and His love. Western Christianity has given us the nomenclature to identify Christians, which is good; the word "Christian" means "little Christ", one who follows, identifies with and acts like Christ. It is more than just worship; it is allowing ourselves to be transformed by interaction with Him and making it a practice to live as He did.

Christ came to establish God's Kingdom on earth. He came to establish more than an orthodox belief system but to lead us into a servanthood lifestyle establishing love, compassion, peace and justice in an unjust world. This leads to some questions for each of us:

- Am I seeking to follow Christ, or am I simply worshiping Him on Sunday?
- In my life do I seek His kingdom by showing love, compassion, sharing peace and working for justice. (And by the way, justice is a positive act not just an act of retribution.)
- Is my Christianity more than cultural morality?
- Do I read the words of Christ in the Gospels to see what He said and how He treated people?

This is not about doing better or more or about churchmanship. This is about following the One we claim has our allegiance. Just some things we all can consider.

May we truly know Him.
