 Tribute to America is on June 27.

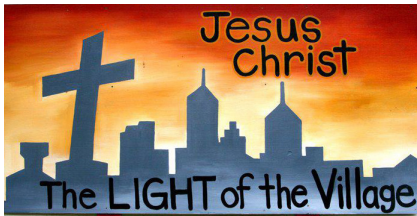
And that is just the first month!
