## PASTORAL SEARCH COMMITTEE ELECTION

Ray Hammock and John Powell were elected to the Pastoral Search Committee on Wednesday July 21st from a ballot of past Chairs of Deacons. They join the current Chair of Deacons, Jim Murill, to form the first three members of the nine-member committee. Church members cast a total of 106 ballots. The remaining six will be selected from Church members at-large.

Phase 2 of the process will take place at 6pm on Wednesday, August 4th during a specially called Church conference. Nominations shall be made by the Church on a written ballot for up to twelve names. Phase 3 of the process will take place on Wednesday, August 18th. The Church will elect the six at-large members from a list of the eighteen members receiving the most nominations.
