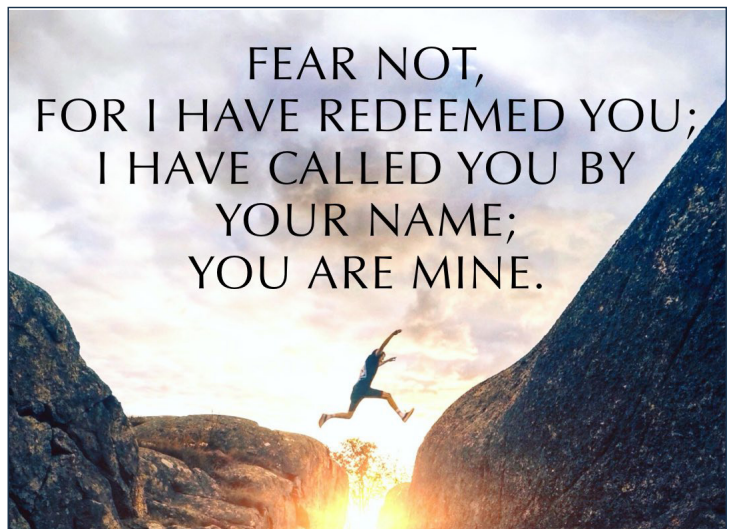
MAGIC: Mature Adults Growing in Christ
