Several years ago at a dinner, I sat next to Scott Rigsby, the first double amputee to complete the world famous Hawaiian Ironman Triathlon. After hearing his story, I thought:

What am I doing with my life? This man endured tremendous challenges yet has accomplished incredible feats. He didn't want glory but wanted to be able to encourage others going through the same trials. I felt as if my life had counted little and that my challenges have been nothing in comparison.

But a still small voice reminded me, "Terry, you aren't Scott. You have your own challenges and experiences. Use them to help others who have experienced some of the same things."

God made each of us unique. Each has his or her place in the world, and each has the opportunity to help someone else. Never sell yourself short. Take what you have and use it to help another.
