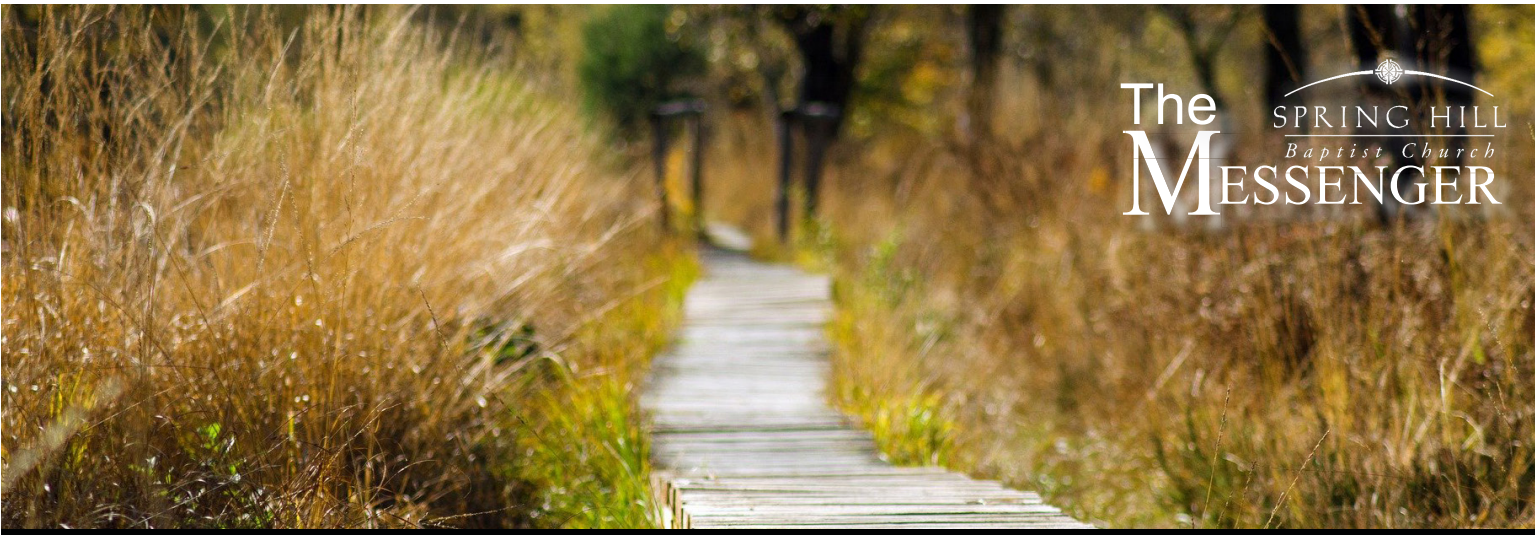

She was my Speech and Drama coach in high school. “Mrs. L,” as we called her, was known for her animated way, her abundant laugh, her unbelievable energy and her deep faith. There was no doubt “Mrs. L” loved every one of her students. She wanted each to succeed. She challenged us, pushed us, encouraged us, chastened us and instructed us.

Not only that, but Mrs. Liveakos also respected and listened to us without demeaning us. That is what made the impact. Oh, there was no doubt where she stood, but no matter our decision, she never abandoned a one of us. I saw her cry over student’s failures and watched her pray at her desk quietly for students. The year I had her for homeroom, she read a scripture, asked us to pray silently and then had us close with The Lord’s Prayer. Mind you, this was a public school, but no one said a word. She said if we didn’t wish to participate, we could stand in the hall and wait. No one left the room. “Mrs. L” showed the love of Christ without being preachy or condescending. She loved us, and we all knew it.

A native of Mobile and graduate of the University of Alabama, she served her country during WWII in the Pentagon, writing letters to families of fallen soldiers. She had lived everywhere from Alabama to Cuba before settling in Tupelo, Mississippi. Ruth Liveakos will always be one of my greatest heroes. She wasn’t trying to be a hero. She was just living her life following Christ. She would be surprised to be called a hero, but she truly influenced everyone she touched.

Are you living a life that one day someone will say, “He or she is my hero, for they showed the love of Christ?” Each of us as Christ-followers are called to allow the Holy Spirit to shine in that way through us, using the unique personality we have been given.

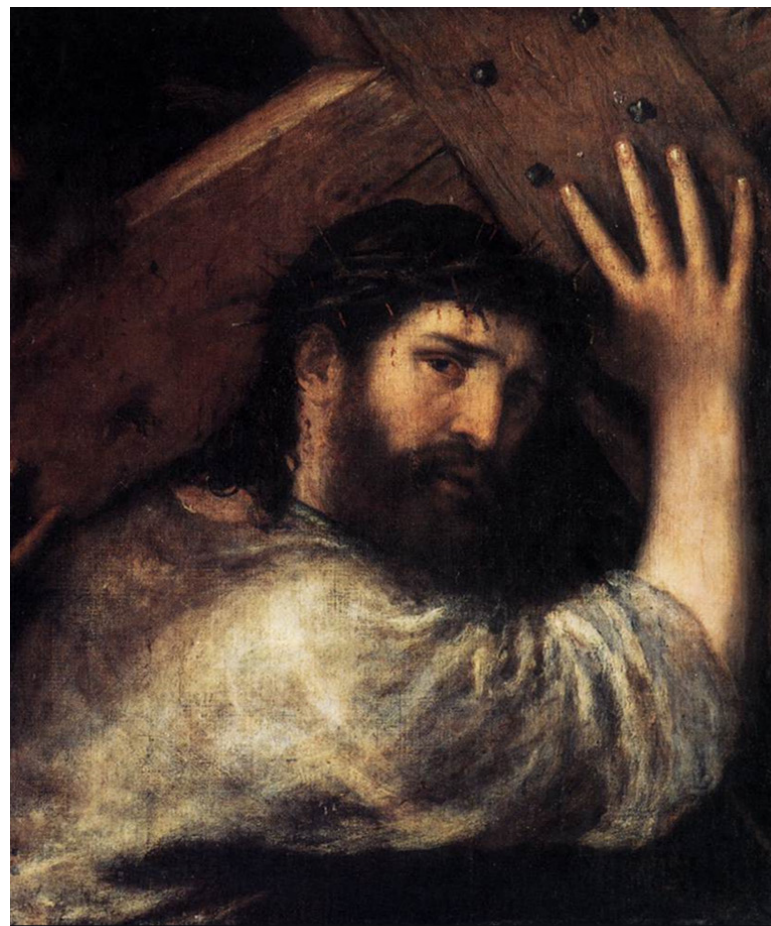
