Orchard Elementary is

located on Howells Ferry Road and is about ten minutes from our church campus.

When this ministry began, we concentrated on the adult needs only, because of Covid restrictions. We provided holiday treats for the teachers and staff in an effort to help boost morale and show appreciation. We have taken treats for the beginning of the school year, for Thanksgiving, for Christmas, for Valentine's Day, for Easter, and for Teacher Appreciation. As Covid restrictions have been relaxed, we have broadened our ministry. We have provided clothes for students in need, we have been able to read to classes, and we were able to help in their summer Reading Camp. In the coming year, we are hoping to be able to help the teachers and students with reading intervention needs.

Also, we have been able to help our own SHBC Day School with identified needs. Our hearts could be identified as Hearts of Service; service to children and their caregivers is the main focus of our ministry.

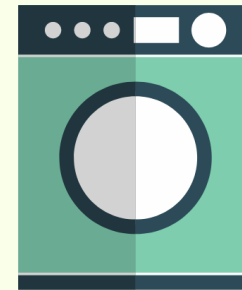
